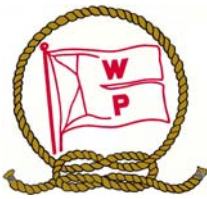

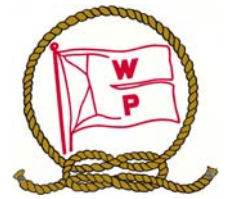

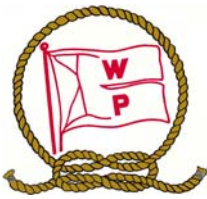

(Wet Pants Sailing Association does not discriminate against prospective members for any reason.)

Wet Pants Sailing Association, also known as the association, offers two forms of membership. Senior Family Membership for one or two individuals 65 or more years old living at the same address and Family Membership for one or two adult family members and their children under the age of 21 who all live in the same household.

Senior Members may attend all club sponsored events, vote at business meetings, and run for elected office or be appointed to association committees. Senior Members do not have dry sail privileges, may not rent a slip, and may not take sailing lessons or sponsor anyone else for sailing lessons. Each Senior Membership is limited to no more than two persons.

Family Membership is for one or two adult family members and their children under the age of 21 who all live in the same household. Family Membership carries all of the advantages of Senior Membership as well as the privilege to rent dry sail space, a slip when available, and/or to enroll in sailing lessons where space for family members is available.

I or we, in return for membership dues (Senior Members or Family Members) and my/our commitment to participate in the meetings, educational, social, and work activities of the club

- ☞ **Are** entitled to the rights and privileges accorded to my/our membership status as explained above in the Wet Pants Sailing Association.
- ☞ **Understand** the cooperative nature of the club and the expectation to participate in its activities and contribute to its success.
- ☞ **Understand** that each family member, 14 years and older, has full membership status and has the right to vote on and to participate in the discussion of all matters concerning the association.

I or we agree:

- ☞ Not to hold Wet Pants Sailing Association responsible for damages or injuries to myself, or members of my family, resulting from club activities.
- ☞ To assume sole responsibility in determining whether or not to sail or race under any given conditions.
- ☞ To remove personal belongings from the building and grounds by the fall clean-up and authorize the Executive Committee to sell or discard **ANYTHING** left after that date (unless winter storage dues are paid).
- ☞ To pay all fees and charges when due.

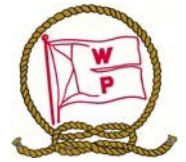

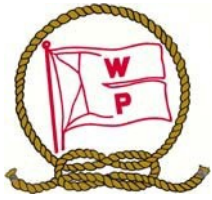

- (1) A volunteer work surcharge of \$25 is included in the family membership dues. A refund/credit is earned when two significant volunteer contributions are made to the club in the previous year. Coordinate with the Rear Commodore to receive credit for your efforts. Your credit (if applicable) will be deducted from the total you owe. Senior Membership of \$20 plus tax per family of two may be elected for those 65 years and older but does not qualify for a surcharge rebate or to take or sponsor sailing lessons nor carry the right to lease Dry-Sail or dock space. (Individuals who have paid \$5 in previous years for a senior membership are grandfathered to the previous \$5 fee.)
- (2) If desired, please complete a dry sail lease agreement. Availability is limited and not guaranteed. Email rear-commodore@wetpantssailing.org to learn if there is space for your boat or to inquire about a boat slip.
- (3) If desired, please complete the sailing class application form. Availability is limited and taken on a first-paid basis. Registration IS NOT VALID WITHOUT PAYMENT IN FULL. Email info@wetpantssailing.org if you have questions.

If paying for dry sail space or sailing lessons you must also complete the Dry Sail Rental Agreement and Sailing School Agreement. Payment in full And Adult Signature is required with all applications.

Application forms may not be altered in any way. There is a \$25 fee for returned checks.
Partial credit WILL NOT BE APPLIED for incorrect or insufficient payments. Entire application will be returned.
