

WET PANTS SAILING ASSOC. CONTRACT TO BORROW A CLUB BOAT

A Wet Pants boat and its equipment, hereafter referred to as the boat, may only be borrowed by a Wet Pants Club Member. The Rear Commodore will evaluate the request based on the requirements and stipulations seen below. The boat may only be skippered by the member whose signature appears here and that person guarantees the boat will be returned in the same condition as when it was borrowed.

Requirements:

1. Wet Pants club boats may only be borrowed when a member is granted approval by the club's rear commodore. When making the decision to loan the boat the rear commodore will consider the member's service to the club, boat handling skill, mature judgment, and a \$25 security deposit which will be stapled to this application.
2. The member completes a contract wherein he accepts responsibility for the undamaged return of the boat and its equipment the day before it is needed for sailing instruction.

Stipulations:

1. The Wet Pants boat will not be needed for sailing instruction during the time it is borrowed.
2. The member and Rear Commodore will meet at the club to inspect the boat and complete a "Contract to Borrow". The contract is not negotiable and may not be changed in any way by the member who wishes to borrow the boat.
3. The borrower shall return the boat to the club the day before it is again needed for instruction. At that time the member and Rear Commodore will inspect the boat. All equipment that was borrowed must be returned in working condition so as not to interrupt the boat's use for Wet Pants sailing instruction. All equipment must then be returned neatly to the place where the sailing school stores that equipment.
4. The member borrowing the boat will forfeit his \$25 deposit in the event the boat or its equipment is returned after the "Contract to Borrow" ends or the equipment is not stored neatly in its place.
5. If the Rear Commodore finds that the boat or its equipment has been damaged while in the possession of the borrower, the borrower agrees to pay the full cost to repair the boat to its former condition or replace the damaged or missing part.
