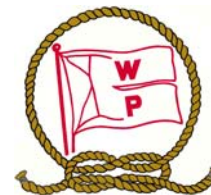

2011-12 Winter Dry-Sail Space Application

You must already be a member in good standing to store your boat for the winter

NOTE: Use an additional form if more than 3 boats need dry sail space.

Terms & Conditions

1. You must be a current member to submit a Dry-Sail Space Application Form.
2. Dry-sail space requests will be evaluated on the basis of boat type, space available, member's activity in Wet Pants Sailing Association, and expected benefit to the club. Requests without payment will not be accepted. SPACE IS LIMITED and NOT guaranteed.

3. In order to process your request, you must provide enough information so that we can identify your boat on sight. You must have an ID label on your boat to use the dry-sail area. If you do not have an ID label for your boat you must get one from the Rear Commodore before you are allowed storage space.
4. Any boat without a WPSA dry-sail sticker will be removed from the dry-sail area. Wet Pants Sailing Association will not accept responsibility for it.
5. **Owners store their boats in the dry-sail area at their own risk.** Wet Pants Sailing Association does not carry insurance for and is not responsible for damage, loss or theft. All boats & personal belongings must be removed from the building & grounds by the Fall Clean-Up, unless winter storage fees have been paid. **Anything left after the Spring Clean-Up may be sold or discarded.**
6. The dry-sail surcharge will not be charged for winter storage.
7. The dry-sail fee is non-refundable.
8. Contact Rear Commodore before the Fall Clean Up to make arrangements. See page 2 for storage instructions.

2011-12 Winter Dry-Sail Space Application

You must already be a member in good standing to store your boat for the winter

The location of a boat in the dry sail area will be determined by the following factors:

1. **Volunteer work** in the dry sail area and around the club house will also factor into location of a boat. An active member who invests their time and energy into the maintenance and improvement of the club's building and grounds will have this factored into their boat location assignments.
2. **Payment.** Payments for dry sail space will be made on time prior to use of the dry sail area. Failure to pay for dry sail space will result in a warning to the boat owner that their boat will be removed.
3. We reserve the right to move your boat when it's in the best interest of the club(eg. such as cleanup, building repairs, boat yard circulation, etc.)

The location assignments for winter storage will be made at the discretion of the Rear Commodore.

Additional Winter Storage Requirements:

- Your boat must have the mast **unstepped** and secured to your boat(if it is to be stored with your boat).
- It is recommended that you keep your boat covered since an accumulation of ice and snow inside the hull will result in damage to both your boat and trailer.
